

No earlier than March 2023, SpaceX's Falcon 9 rocket will launch the *Polaris Dawn* mission from historic Launch Complex 39A at Kennedy Space Center in Florida. Dragon and the *Polaris Dawn* crew will spend up to five days in orbit, during which they will work towards the following objectives: Highest Altitude Space, Health Impact Research, In-space Communications, and the First Commercial Spacewalk.














get us through the year. We shared some goal setting for 2023. The January social found us playing Bunco. Most for the first time! It was loads of laughs and something we will definitely do again!
